

Rocker cover racer template

This template was created for the Kids class racer using skateboard trucks and an original A series steel rocker cover. It can also be used for any A series rocker racer as it gives you the inside dimensions of the cover and the correct placement of the rocker cover bolts. Please note that all covers are not created equal. Some slight modifications might be needed to fit your cover. The cover bolt mounts will always be correct as long as you keep the center cross centered.

Depending on the size of the paper you can print, you might need to do the following:

- 1. Go to your printer and choose Landscape, then go to Layout.
- 2. Choose to reposition images to the left and print one, then print again at the right.
- 3. Take both pages and set them on a window on a sunny day. Overlap them to line up everything exactly to create the full length template. Tape them together and then cut the outline. Confirm that the center of the cover mounting holes is 9" (22.86cm). Now you have a template, go build a racer!
